

he abruptly snapped, "don't talk to kids." I tried to ask him further questions, but he rudely cut me off and got off the telephone.

Allegedly, the main perpetrator, in my son's own words, was a man they called "Visitor" who had been living with "Daddy and Nancy" (and Nancy's three (3) small children by another man) and who had run away from home and had black spiked hair (that he repeated to my mother, Susan Elaine Saloom, Julian's maternal grandmother, family pediatrician, Dr. Kagan, Kagan Pediatrics, and Pearland Police Officers French and Evans, Pediatric Nurse, Michelle Householder and Texas Children's Hospital Social Worker, Sandra Rosinski-Russell). I had reluctantly made the aforementioned report via telephone (TX DFPS Statewide Intake Hotline) at approximately 6:30PM on Wednesday, May 02, 2012 after speaking on the telephone on the same day around 5:00PM with Dr. Kagan to determine whether or not I should take Julian in for an exam. Dr. Kagan spoke with Julian on the phone, as Julian was very outspoken about wanting to finally tell and get this over with for good. Dr. Kagan advised me to phone CPS immediately after hanging up the phone with him, as he was obligated to report it. He also advised me to take Julian to Texas Children's Hospital for what is known, at least on the discharge papers, as an "SAE" (Sexual Assault Exam).

Immediately upon entering the CPS office, Ms. Harvick separated me from my son by saying she needed to speak to "Mommy" in private. Once she removed my son from the room where she had sat me down while no one else was present (at least, not yet), she ushered Officers Paul Elton, Badge # 106
