Officer Brown, and Detective R. Alvarado (Pearland Police Department, 2555 Cullen Parkway, Pearland, TX 77584; Telephone #: (281) 997-4133) into the room with us. Both she and Officer Elton gave me a harsh verbal reprimand for making a complaint to the Office of Consumer Affairs about her employee, and Officer Elton very angrily threatened me about ever going to "talk smack" about him at his precinct again. At that point, Ms. Harvick slapped a court order (Cause No. 67979, Brazoria County, TX, 300<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, signed by Judge Randy Hofstetler) titled, Order In Aid of Investigation of Child Abuse or Neglect) on the table in front of me that she said allowed her to take Julian for the purposes of the investigation, specifically, to the Children's Assessment Center (CAC) at 2500 Bolsover, Houston, TX 77006. Officer Elton threw my valid Texas driver's license at me and Ms. Harvick menacingly assured me that there was absolutely no way my son was going home with me.

At approximately 2:00PM Sergeant William Lilly entered the room where everyone but me was standing in uniform. I was definitely not in a situation in which it was reasonable to expect that I was free to move or leave the room, let alone to leave with my only child whom I have raised without incident largely by myself to be the super healthy, adorable, highly intelligent and happy child Julian presents himself to be. Both Ms. Harvick and Sergeant Lilly continued to interrogate me under duress, threat, and coercion despite the fact that when Sergeant Lilly sat down next to me and demanded I tell him why I had brought him here today, I asserted that he and Ms. Harvick had asked me to come as
